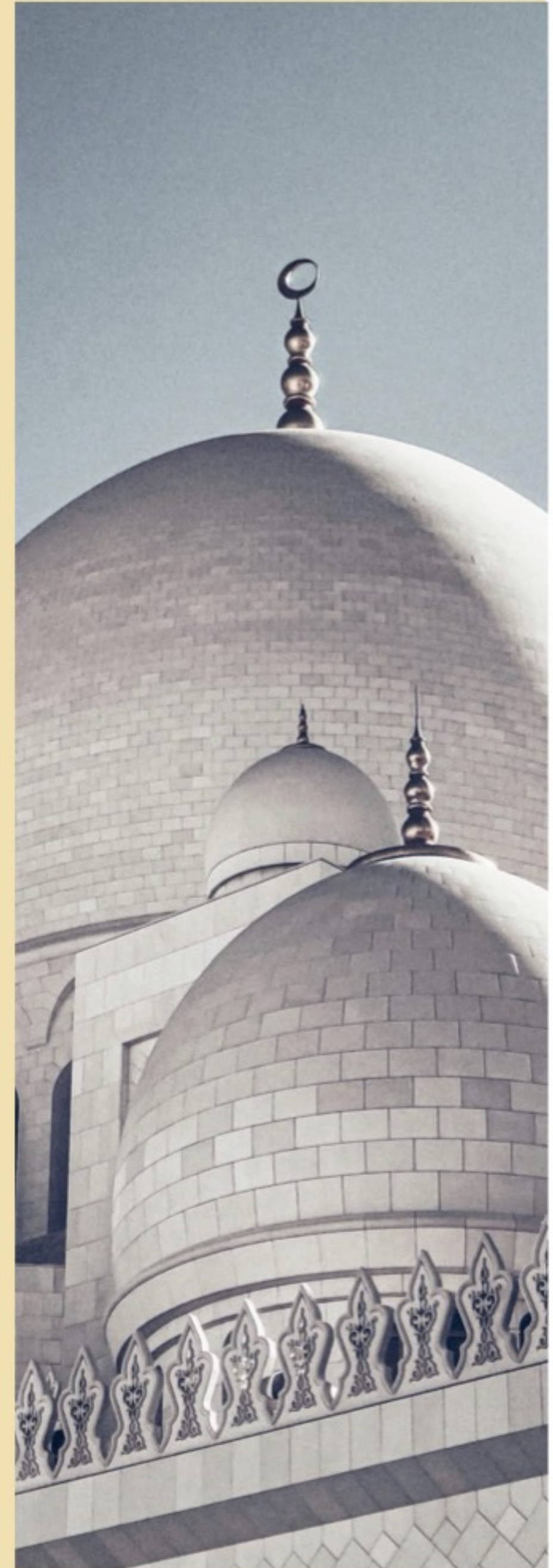

Media scholar Omar Sayfo notes, "All in all, 'Freej' advocates for a modern Emirati national identity that fuses traditional values with modern achievements."

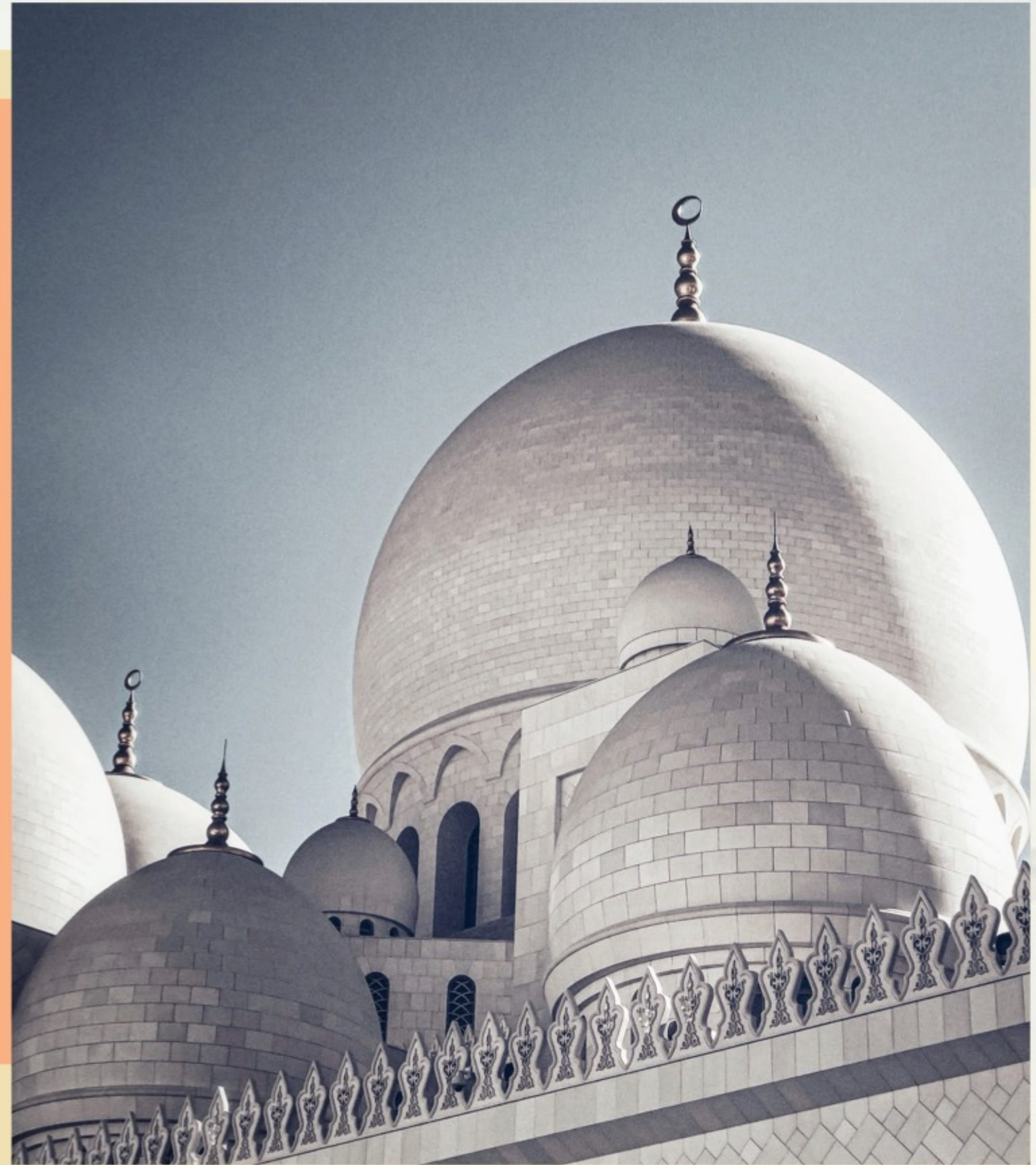

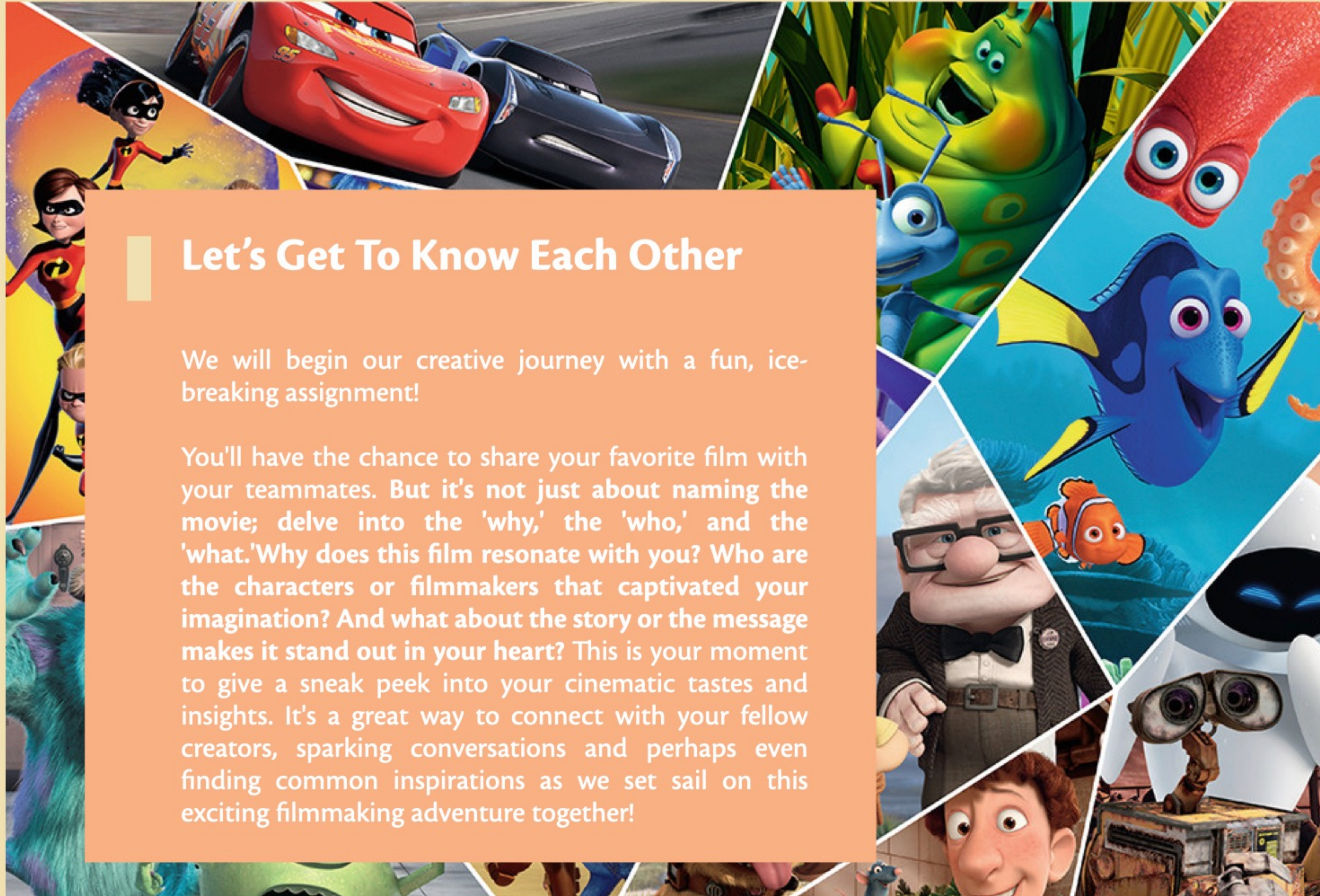
Think of FigJam as a giant, interactive whiteboard on your screen. You can doodle, draw flowcharts, stick virtual post-it notes, or even create mind maps.

What Makes a Winning Project?

Engages the Audience

Does the project make people think and feel something?

Tells a Clear Story

Is the message of tolerance clear and impactful?

Uses Film Techniques Effectively

Are visuals and sound helping to tell the story?

Reflects the Theme of Tolerance

Does it highlight coexistence, empathy, or cultural understanding?



Grading Criteria

Integration tolerance (20%)	The original idea seamlessly integrates the theme of tolerance, demonstrating creativity and deep insight, with engaging and well-aligned content.	The idea connects well with the theme of tolerance. While the approach is clear and relevant, consider adding more depth or unique perspectives to further enhance its impact.	The integration of the theme of tolerance is evident but lacks depth and clarity. Consider refining your idea to establish a stronger connection to the themes and objectives. Script (20%)	The script excellently connects and explores the subject of tolerance, with clear, engaging, and insightful content that aligns perfectly with the objectives. The script addresses tolerance but lacks depth or clarity in its connection to the subject.	The script does not effectively connect with or explore the topic of tolerance, missing key elements or clarity.
Storyboard (10%)	The storyboard supports the script and provides a clear, detailed guide for the production process, enhancing the team's understanding and workflow.	The storyboard supports the script well but could include more detailed or clearer instructions for production.	The storyboard provides basic support for the script but lacks details that would inform the production process effectively.	The storyboard is underdeveloped, offering little support for the script or production process.
Final Film (40%)	The film supports the goals of the script, raising awareness about tolerance effectively. It is outstanding in both technical and creative aspects.	The film supports the script's goals well and raises awareness about tolerance, with competent technical and creative execution.	The film somewhat supports the script's goals but is limited in raising awareness about tolerance. Technical and creative aspects are average.	The film fails to support the script's goals and does not effectively raise awareness about tolerance, with poor technical and creative quality.
